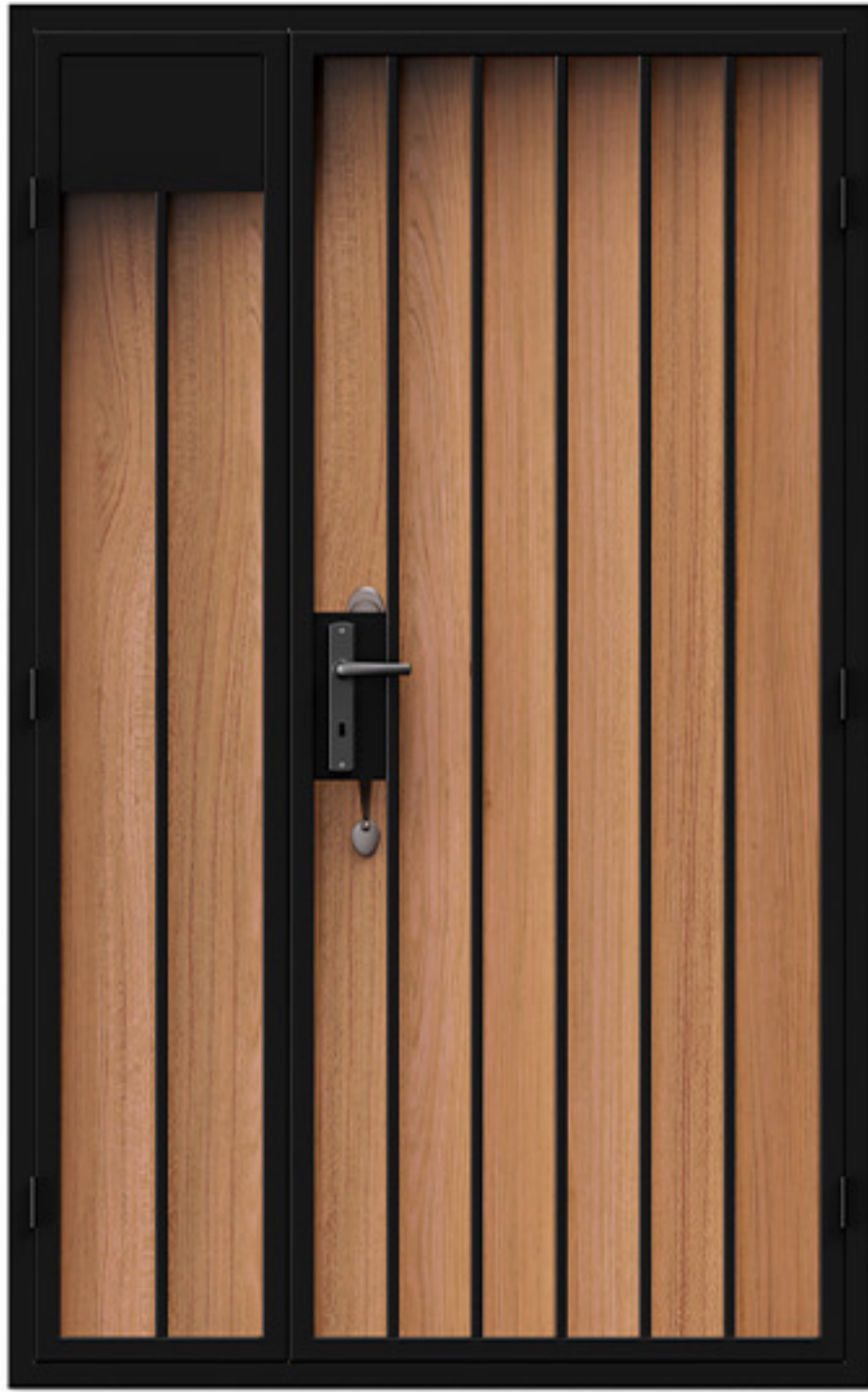


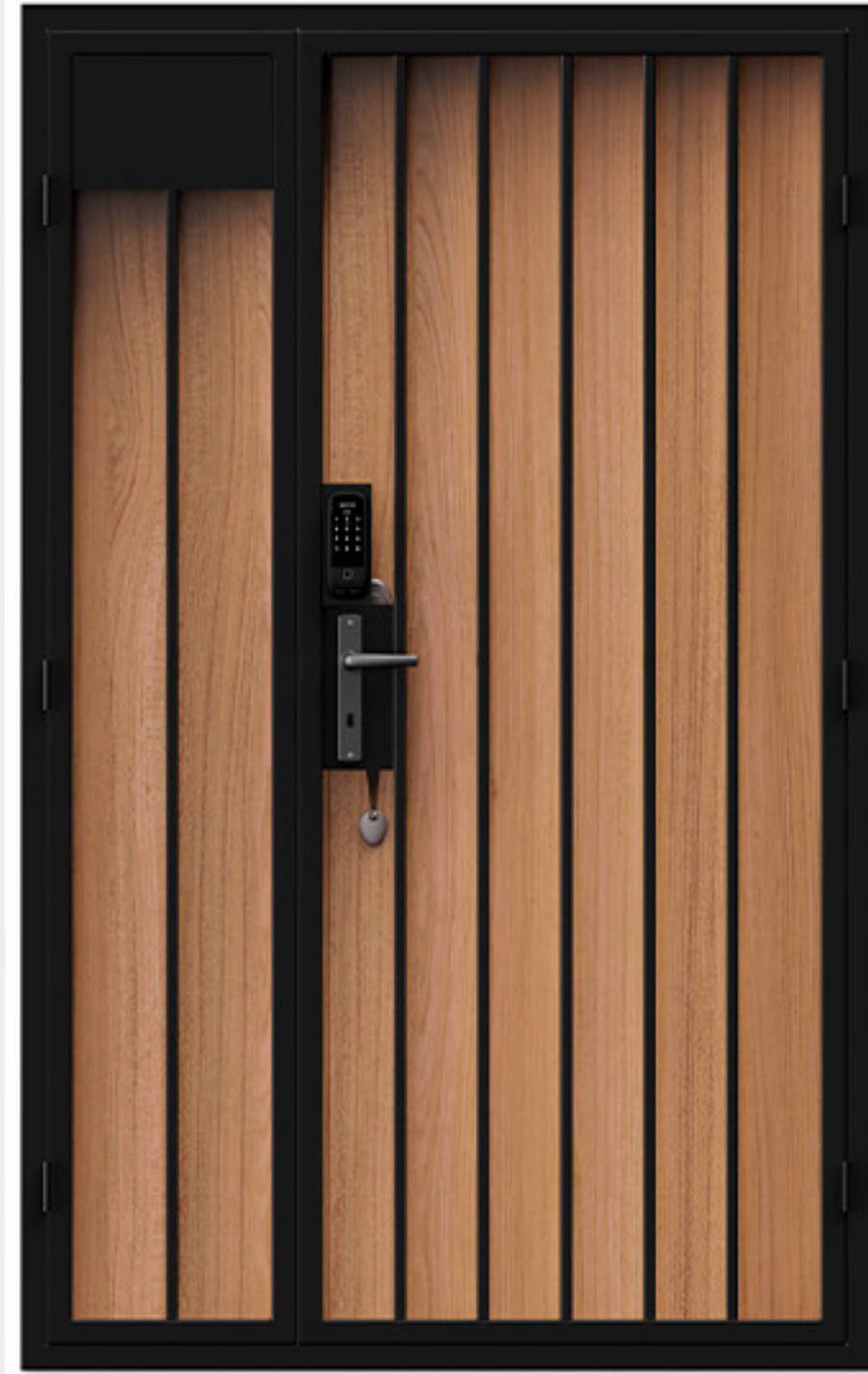

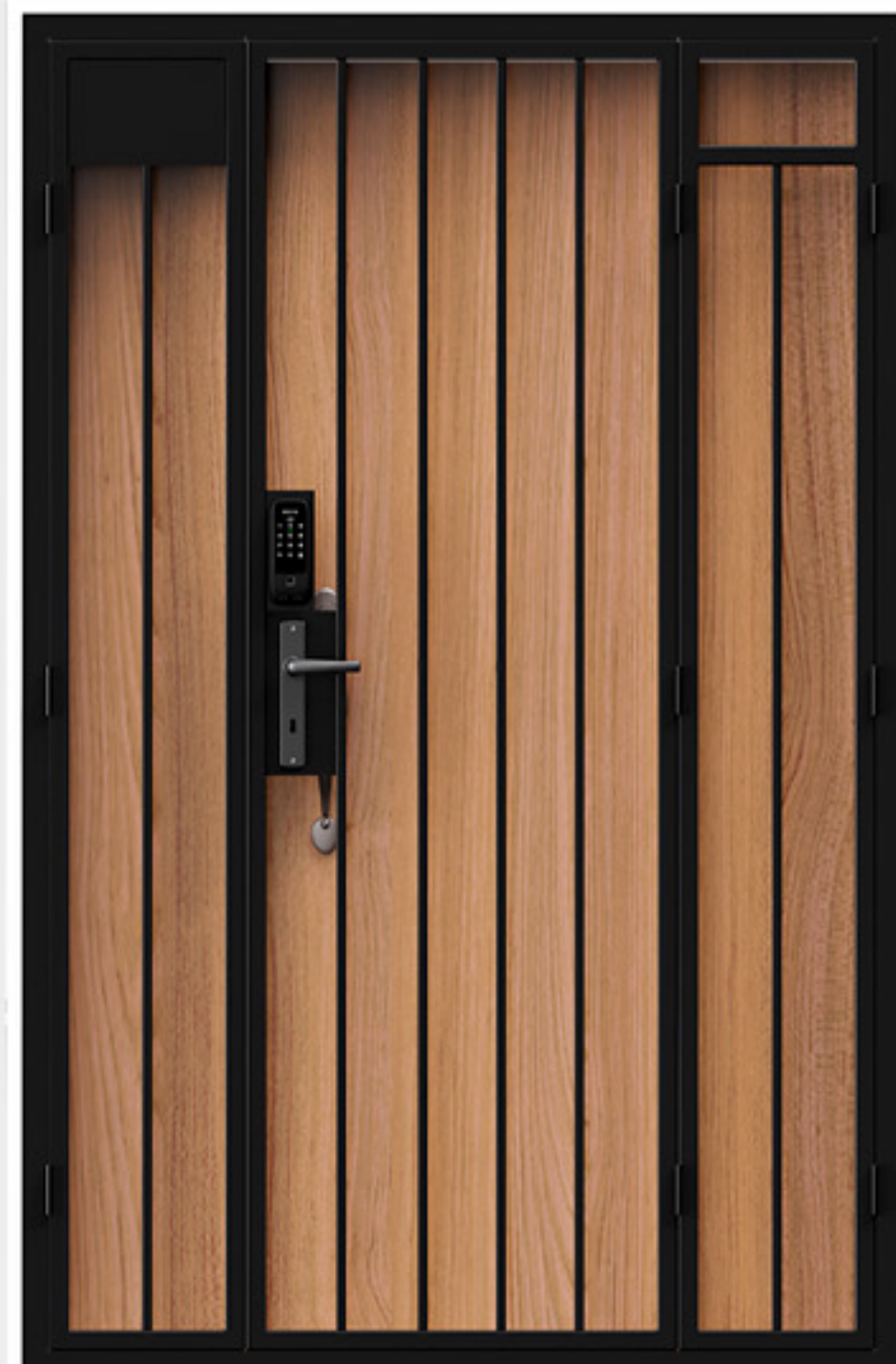


## **Triple-leaf Metal Gate**

**1. Ensure there is enough space to fit the provided wooden block on the larger leaf of the gate.**



**Size of Wooden Block:** 72 (W) x 202 (H) mm

**Wooden Block Thickness:** 30mm

## 2. Ensure that the gate thickness and type is suitable for Gate Lock.



**Gate Type:** Single-leaf, Double-leaf and Triple-leaf gates  
(Best installed on Double-leaf and Triple-leaf gates)

**Gate Thickness:**  $\leq 30\text{mm}$

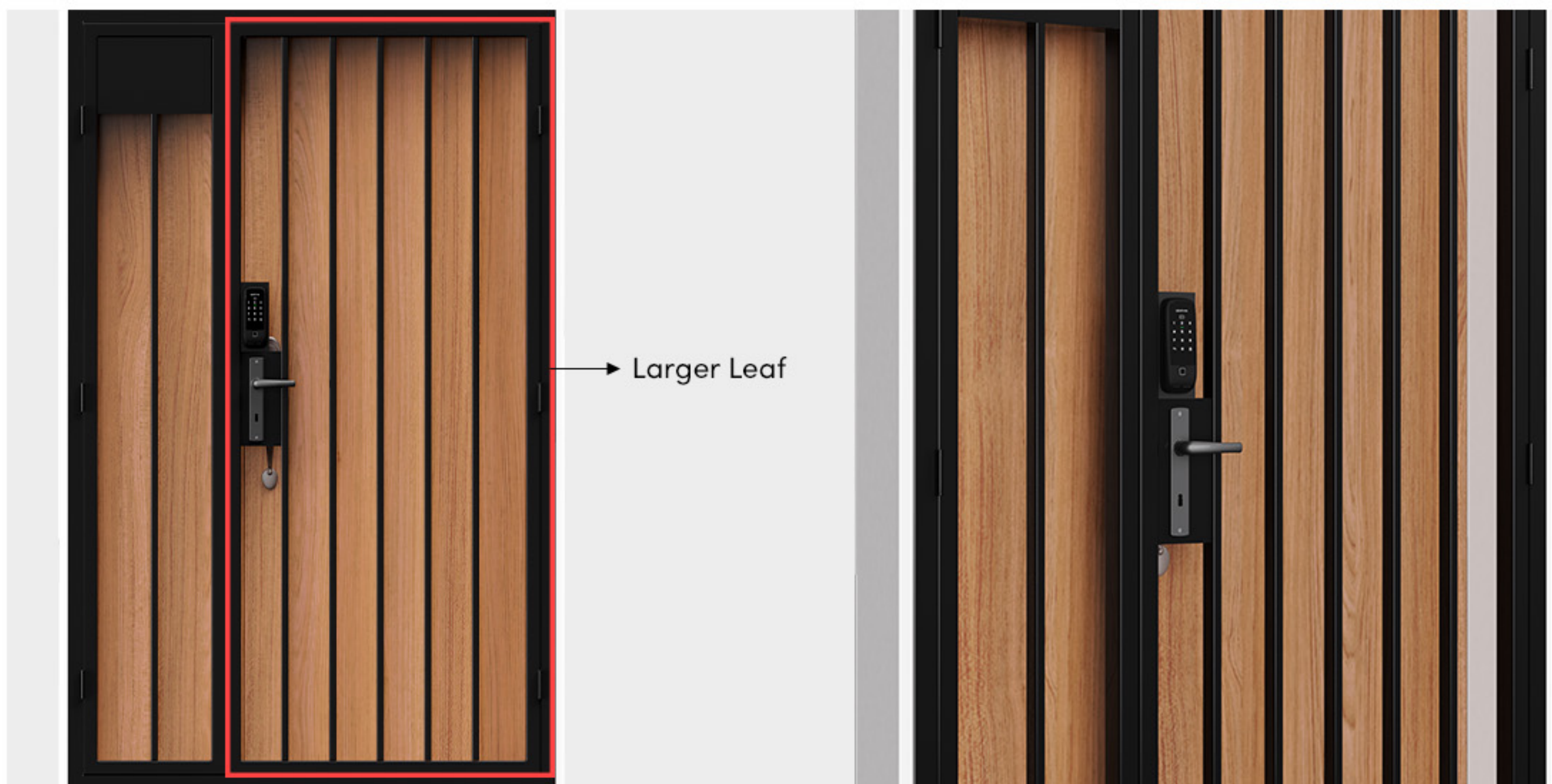
## 3. Ensure that there is enough clearance between door and gate.



Distance between door and gate for Gate Lock: 45mm

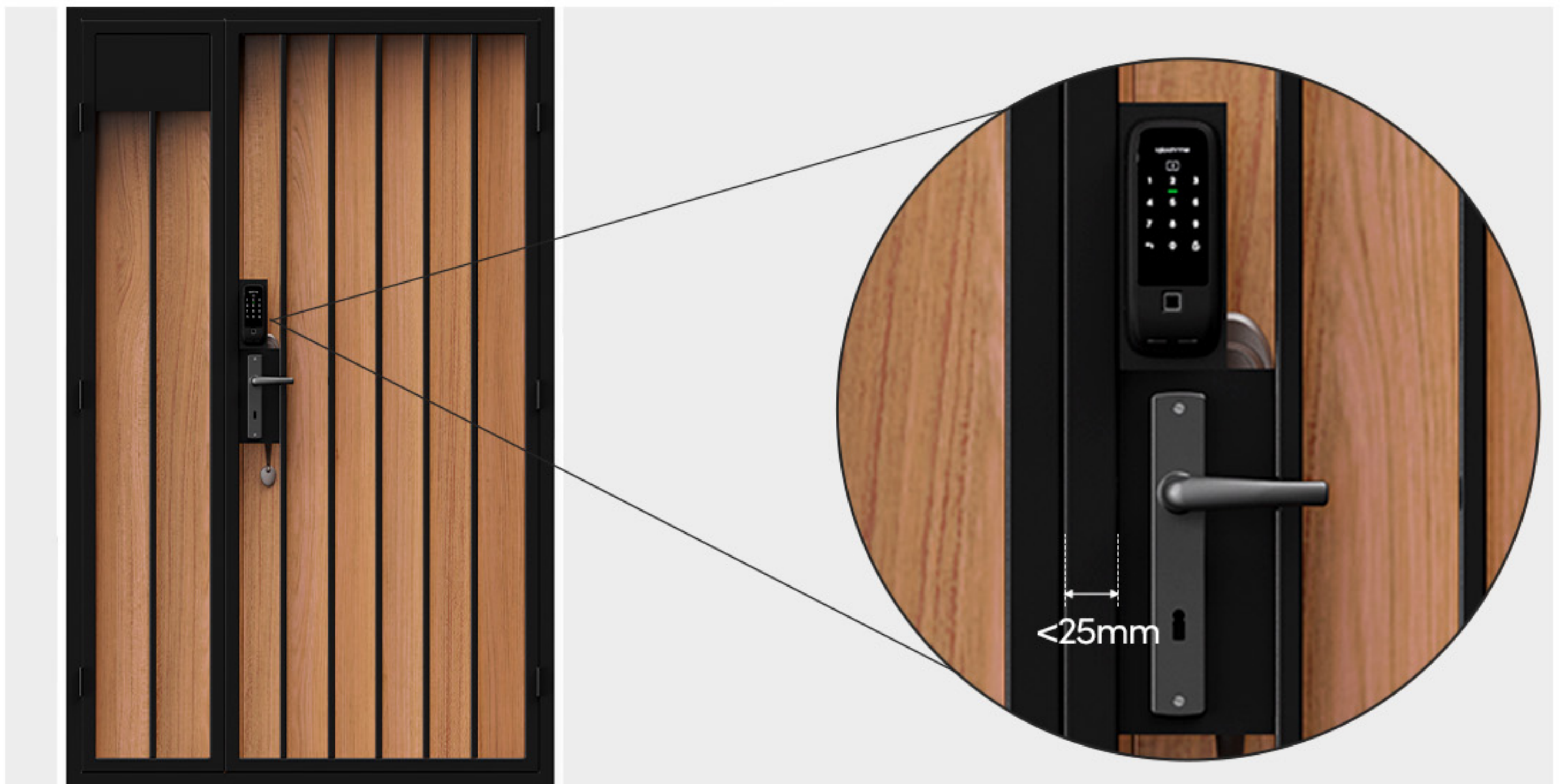


## 4. Ensure to install only on the larger leaf of metal gate.



\*There will be obstruction if installed on smaller leaf of metal gate since striker needs to protrude out.

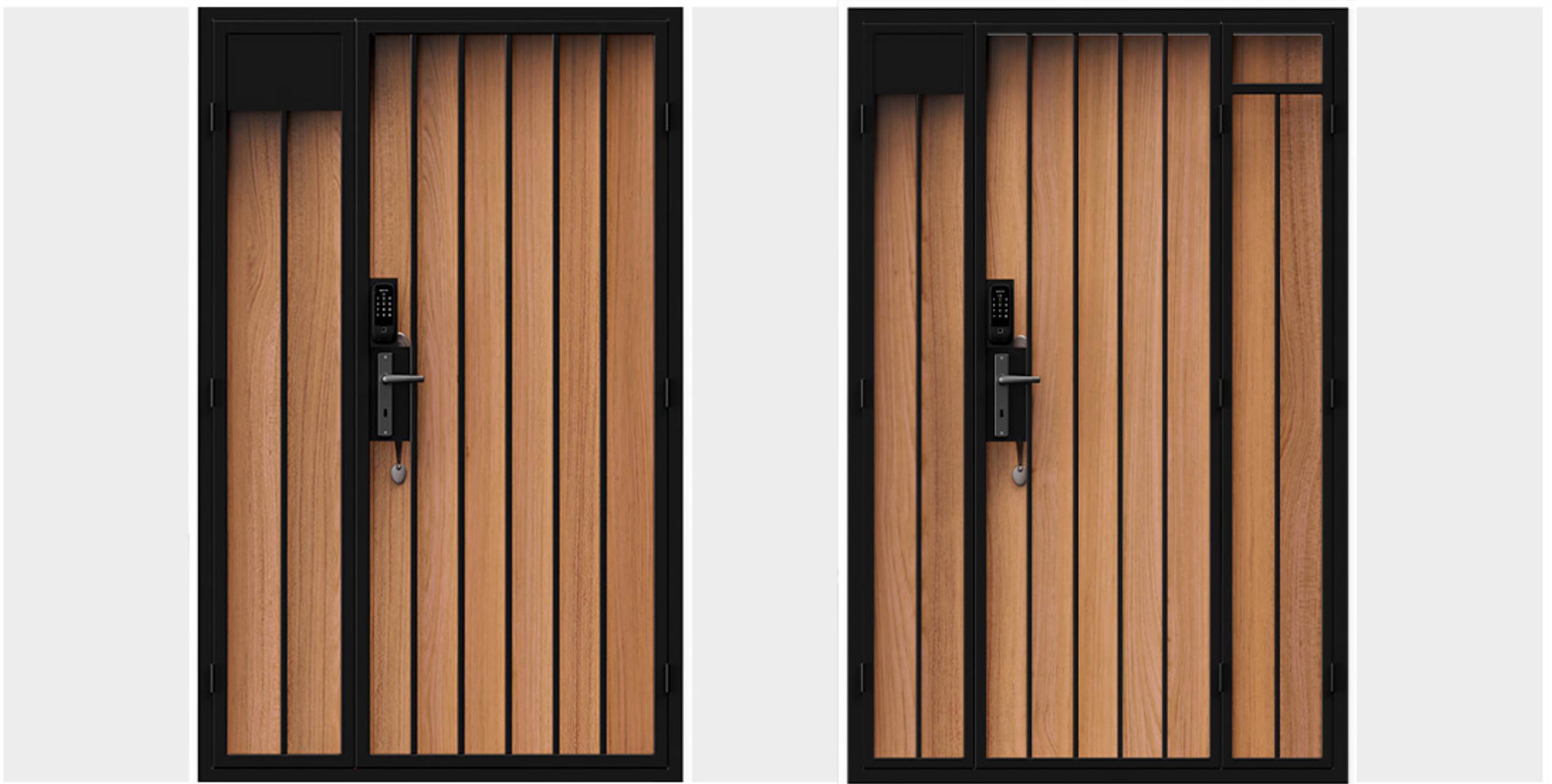
## 5. Ensure that the big leaf gate's horizontal bar thickness is <25mm.



Horizontal Bar Thickness: <25mm



### **6. Ensure that your metal gate grill design is suitable for Gate Lock.**

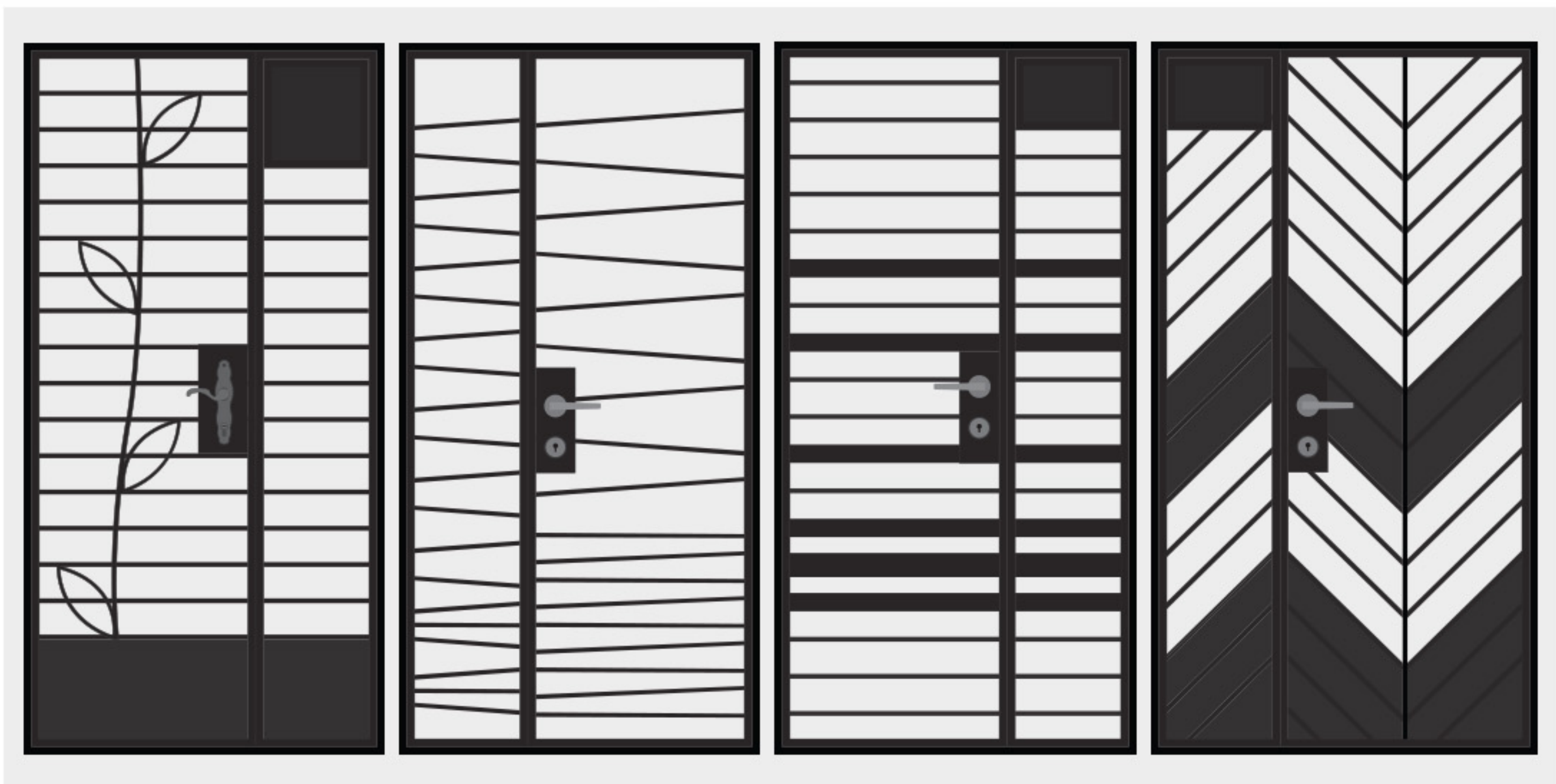
